The block makers hand-carve the designs, while the color makers mix the dyes and paints and fabric makers spin and weave the cotton. From there, the print makers use the block designs to stamp the cotton fabric and bag makers cut and sew to produce the item that is checked for quality before it is sent out to you! You can find photos, names and information for each artisan that makes up these groups on Joyn's website.

Joyn is a part of the Fair Trade Federation, meaning that they provide fair, liveable wages and working environments for their employees. They are transparent about who makes their goods, how they are made and where they are made.

Joyn offers a beautiful, unique and ever-revolving collection of bags from wallets to weekenders. You may recognize them from some of our Fair Trade Friday boxes.

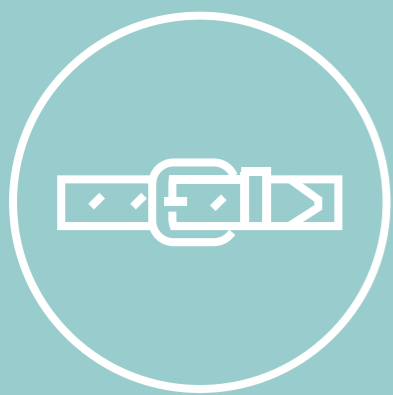

The women at Daughters Of Hope are given health insurance, lunches, free childcare and lessons on things such as personal hygiene. Though many of the women came to Daughters Of Hope impoverished and uneducated, all are now professional tailors whose products are sold nationwide via glory haus.

Glory Haus has also partnered with MUST ministries to create an artisan workroom in the United States: Repurposed on Purpose. All of the products from this collection are handmade by women who have been rescued and are now transitioning out of difficult situations. Glory Haus offers an expansive collection of home and holiday décor. Repurposed on Purpose provides beautiful leather accessories for women.
